1. Discussion. City of Stockbridge Zoning

3. Aggressive dog in a rental house at 1031 Chad's Ridge.

Ronnie has notified them and let them know they can't let the dog run loose in the neighborhood. Animal control has been called but has not caught the dog without a leash. Nicky will notify the property management tomorrow. The board is concerned about the safety of the neighbors.

Proposed process for holding homeowners responsible for controlling animals:

- 1.Verbal Warning
- 2. Written Warning next time will be fined.
- 3. Written Warning and Fine \$250

Board voted unanimously to approve this action. It will be added to our By Laws. Melissa will draft a form letter for HOA Board to use.

4. Board will review By Laws and discuss updates at the next meeting.

Considerations for By Law Updates:

- Management/Owner should be required to provide a lease and renter contact info to the HOA.
- Could require management companies to provide a yearly lawn care contract.
- Solar Panel guidelines.
- Animal Control warning and fine process.

5. Neighborhood Gathering.

Should we consider a neighborhood gathering to meet each other? Yes, in the fall. We should discuss at the next meeting. Alford thinks his wife would be willing to help organize.

6. Neighborhood speed bumps.

Annual meeting – homeowners asked us to poll the neighbors and find if possible. Nicky suggests including a ballot in the fall newsletter to ask homeowners to vote.
